- Cant fund across sem in discretionary
- Would be willing to pay out of pocket cant fund ex post facto though
- Sounds reasonable request
- Would be open to the entire student body

# 5. Theater and Dance Dept & Gender and Justice Group (rep by Reily and Ryan)

- Want to bring a by written by Hampshire alum to campus in Feb 8-10
- About pro choice vs pro life choices
- Have been touring across the country
- Wrtier would also be doing a workshop with students
- Total budget is  $\sim 6.1$ k
  - o For the show and also a speaker expert on reproductive justice
- Theater and dance is providing the space and technical needs
- Getting support from women and genders center
- Also seeking support from a number of other sources on campus lecture fund, academic dept
- RJ Can't fund across semesters. Also, concerned about degree to which administration is coming to BC requesting for money, using student activities funds to fund things that the school should be funding
  - Are giving the space and lighting equip, etc for free
- This request would be coming from the student group (Gender and Justice Group)
- This is coming directly from a student group rather than an administrative group
- Richard would be better if theater and dance dept not be involved in this?
- Marie that's not necessarily true. Said that they were seeking cosponsorship from other sources
- If they came back with a better idea of the cosponsorship fundings, would they still be halved and come back again?
  - o RJ would depend on the amount they get, etc
- Cannot do ex post facto funding
