Yurii Pavlovich Ivask

Biography

Yurii Pavlovich Ivask was born in Moscow, Russia, on September 1, 1907. His father, Pavel Ivask, was of Estonian-German origin; and his mother Evgenia Ivask, nee Frolov, was related to many old merchant families of Moscow, included the Zhivagos and Matveyevs. After the 1917 revolution his family moved to Estonia (1920), where he studied law at the University of Tartu, pursuing his literary interests as a member of the "Guild of Poets" in Tallinn. In 1943 he married Tamara Mezak (d. 1982). After law school, Ivask worked as a tax inspector in the Pechora region and together with Sterna L'vovna Schliffstein founded the literary journal *A Russian Shop* which served as a prototype for Pavel Irtel's almanac *Nov'* [*Virgin Soil*]. Together they published the fiction of Alexei Remizov and Boris Poplavskii as well as their own poetry. A significant meeting of this period was with poet Igor Chinnov in Latvia.

Displaced to Germany by the World War II, he studied Slavic languages and literature at the University of Hamburg. A visit to Paris brought meetings with the emigre literary scene there including Tsvetaeva (with whom he had earlier begun to correspond), Z. N. Hippius (Gippius), and D. S. Merezhkovskii (Merezhkovsky). In 1949 he emigrated to the United States and began an academic career at Harvard, where he was offered the position of visiting lecturer and received his Ph.D. in Russian literature in 1954 (dissertation: "Vjazemskii as a Literary Critic"). He became a United States citizen in 1955. During this period Ivask also edited *In the West: An Anthology of Russian Emigre Poetry* (New York: Chekhov, 1953) and the literary journal *Opyty* (New York: M. Tsetlin, 1953-58).

Ivask taught Russian literature at the University of California, Berkeley (1956), Kansas University (1956-1960), University of Washington in Seattle (1960-1968), Vanderbilt University (1968-1969), and as Professor of Russian Literature at the University of Massachusetts in Amherst from 1969 until he became Emeritus in 1977. He also taught for a number of summers at Middlebury College. Beyond his teaching duties and mentoring of graduate students, Ivask was a prolific poet and essayist. His published collections of poems include: Severny bereg: stikhi 1933-36 (Warsaw: Svyashchennaya lira, 1938); Tsarskaya osen': vtoraya kniga stikhov (Paris: Rifma, 1953); Khvala (Washington, DC: Kamkin, 1967); and Zolushka (New York: Mosty, 1970). He wrote numerous essays on V. Rozanov and O. Mandelshtam, as well as introductions to their published works. He wrote a monograph on the philosopher and essayist K. Leontiev (Konstantin Leont'ev: zhizn' i tvorchestvo, Bern, 1974) and edited a two-volume edition of his works. Essays on other Russian poets include Batyushkov, Boratynskii, Fet, Sluchevskii, Tsvetaeva, Pasternak, Belyi, Georgii Ivanov, Mikhail Kuzmin, Blok, Akhmatova, and Khlebnikov, many of which appeared in his work *Pokhvala Rossijskoy Poezii*. Scholarly and critical articles by him appeared regularly in such organs of the American and European emigre press as *Novoye* Russkoye Slovo, Russkaya Mysl, Sovremennik, The Slavic Review, The Russian Review, The Slavic and East European Journal, and Zeitschrift für slavische Philologie. He was an active member of AATSEEL (American Association of Teachers of Slavic and East European Languages) and lecturer at universities in the United States and in Europe.

Ivask's desire to reach the Russian audience led to broadcasts for Radio Liberty and Radio Vatican as well as Samizdat publications, including that of his *Homo Ludens* and a series of religious, philosophical, cultural and historical reflections. This effort was facilitated in Russia by

his friend, cultural historian Aleksandr N. Bogoslovskii, who in turn copied and sent him archival research materials on Rozanov, Leontiev, etc.

Ivask took various trips abroad. Besides pencil sketches, diaries, and notes on art and architecture, these gave rise to poetry and published travelogues. One such (*Stranstvija*) describes his travels following the footsteps of Leontiev in Greece. Other writings apply to Western Europe generally, Mexico (his lyric cycle *Zavojevanie Meksiki*), Mt. Athos, Portugal, and Moscow.

Ivask died in Amherst in February 1986.

Description of the Papers

Scope and Content Note

The Papers document the professional and personal activities of Yurii Pavlovich Ivask (1907-1986). They reflect chiefly his life-long involvement with Russian literature and culture as a poet, essayist, and scholar in the context of the Russian emigre and academic community.

The 37.25 linear feet of materials include: extensive correspondence; subject files; drafts and published versions of poems, essays, and books; photocopied articles; reprints; research materials chiefly on Russian poets and writers, including many clippings; personal materials such as family documents, diaries and sketchbooks; photographs, many of them of family in Russia and Estonia; and teaching materials, including slides, tapes, and filmstrips. The bulk of the material is written in Russian, the next most frequent languages being English and German. A small amount is also in Polish, Portuguese, French, and Greek. The materials date from 1867 until Ivask's death, the bulk of the collection dating from 1935 to 1985.

Ivask's interests and career connected him with the entire community of Russian emigre writers, poets and thinkers. This connection developed in his Baltic years (until 1945; acquaintance with I. Chinnov, N. E. Andreyev et al.), broadened especially through travel to Paris (acquaintance with Tsvetaeva, Hippius (Gippius), Merezhkovskii, etc.) and his Hamburg years (1945-1949), and continued throughout his life in America (1949-1986) as a professor, scholar, poet and essayist.

Among the correspondence of significance or magnitude in the Papers are letters to and from: Georgii Adamovich, Nikolai Andreyev, Aleksandr Bakhrakh, Nikolai Berdyaev, Iosif Brodskii, Ivan Bunin, Igor Chinnov, Tatiana Fesenko, Boris Filippov, Rev. Kirill Fotiev, Pavel Gribanovskii, Roman Goul, Roman Grynberg, Roger Hagglund, Johannes Holthusen, Felix Ingold, Simon Karlinskii, Robin Kemball, Gennadii Khomiakov, Yurii Mamleev, Nadezhda Mandelshtam, Nikolai Morshen, Vladimir Markov, Sydney Monas, Serge Prince Obolenskii, Irina Odoevtseva, Valerii Pereleshin, Boris Poplavskii, Sofia Pregel, Aleksis Rannit, Aleksei Remizov, Rev. Vl. Rimskii-Korsakov, Princess Janet Romanova, Tatiana Rozanova, Rev. Aleksandr Shmeman, Vsevolod Setschkareff, Zinaida Shakhovskaya, Andrei Siniavsky, Heinrich Stammler, Anatolii Shteiger, Gleb Struve, Yurii Terapiano, Victor Terras, Vladimir Weidle, Sergei Zenkovskii.

The Papers also include photocopies of correspondence between Bunin and Adamovich, Bryusov and Merezhkovskii, and copies of letters from Tsvetaeva to Ivask. They also include much personal correspondence between Ivask and his wife Tamara, his parents Pavel and Evgenia Ivask, and his cousin Elena Kulpa.

Series Description

Series 1, Correspondence, First Series, 1929-1986 [1949-1985], 7 linear feet, contains correspondence which arrived prior to the bulk of the Papers. Correspondence, Second Series contains letters to or from the same correspondents. Series 3, Professional and Research Materials, also contains correspondence connected with materials there, particularly with publishers.

Series 2, Correspondence, Second Series, 1935-1956 [1951-1983], 2 linear feet, contains Ivask's family correspondence as well as general correspondence, as in Series 1. Series 3, **Professional and Research Materials**, which contains copies of Ivask's correspondence donated in 1964 to Yale University, should also be consulted. Box 7 contains unidentified correspondence from Series 2 sorted later and arranged in chronological order.

The correspondence of the Series 1 and 2 reflects Ivask's professional, literary, and personal life and activities. Ivask corresponded with numerous literary and academic figures, and cultivated correspondences with several outstanding poets and philosophers. See the Scope and Content Note for a selected list of the most voluminous or significant correspondences.

Ivask donated much of his most valued correspondence to the Yale University Archives in 1964; hence these letters (from Adamovich, Berdyaev, Bunin, Merezhkovskii, Tsvetaeva, Zaitsev, et al.) are presented only in the form of copies. (See Series 6, Personal Materials, box 34, folders 34-36.)

Series 3, **Professional and Research Materials**, 1885-1985 [1935-1985], 15 linear feet contains drafts of Ivask's books *Pokhvala rossijskoy poezii* and *K. Leontiev*, drafts of his anthology of Russian emigre poetry, his dissertation on Vjazemskii and of his various works on Rozanov. It also contains extensive teaching materials, essays, and articles including notes and drafts; interviews (with Ivask); correspondence with publishing houses, journals, and newspapers (and occasional other correspondence); reviews by and of Ivask associated with particular authors or works; research materials and clippings and literary topics and figures, religion, etc.; miscellaneous notes and clippings. Box 23, a later addendum is arranged in alphabetical order and may contain research and professional material related to people listed in the beginning of this series; note cards with bibliographical notes and comments. Also contained here are M. Tsvetaeva's letters to Ivask, hand-copied by Ivask along with his commentary for publication.

Materials sent to Ivask from Russia by Aleksandr Bogoslovskii are usually signed in Russian with A. N.

Series 4, **Writings**, 1930-1986 [1955-1985], 5 linear feet, is divided into several subseries: *Poems* (both in alphabetical and chronological order), *Translations by and of Ivask* (in chronological order by the earliest date in the folder), *Poems by Others or Uknown Authors* (in chronological order), *Stories* (in alphabetical order), *Samizdat Articles and Reflections* (in alphabetical order); *Reviews by Ivask* (in chronological order); *Journal and Newspaper Publications* (in chronological order); *Reviews of Ivask's Work* (in chronological order); *Articles by Others* (in chronological order). The *Poems* are grouped as follows: poems organized alphabetically by name of collection; poems loosely grouped by date of origin; miscellaneous poems by Ivask; and miscellaneous poems by others. The *Stories* are divided into short stories (and drama) by Ivask and stories by unidentified authors. *Samizdat Articles and Reflections* contains articles and philosophical or religious reflections, many of which were sent to be distributed by *Samizdat* in Russia. The *Journal and Newspaper Publications* contain a collection of Ivask's articles, essays and reviews in the form of photocopied clippings or journal reprints. The subseries *Articles by Others* contains articles by others, collected by Ivask.

Series 5, **Diaries, Sketchbooks and Artwork**, 1923-1982 [1925-1980], 2.25 line ar feet, is divided into two subseries: *Diaries* and *Sketchbooks and Artwork*. Ivask's personal *Diaries* were kept fairly systematically in the earlier years, and more loosely later. His *Sketchbooks and Artwork*, done in colored pencil or ink, form a personal pictorial record of his trips to Mexico and Europe.

Series 6, **Personal Materials**, 1907-1986 [1933-1980], 2.5 linear feet, is divided into *Personal Materials* and *Student Materials*. The *Personal Materials* contain biographical materials, employment papers and curriculum vitae; immigration materials for Evgenia Ivask (his mother); materials relating to Ivask's family and ancestors; religious and other mementos. It also contains Ivask's transactions with the Yale University Archives in regard to his sale of a portion of his correspondence to them, and photocopies of this correspondence, including Z. Hippius (Gippius). The *Student Materials* contain notes and essays by Ivask from his student days, mostly from Hamburg and Harvard.

Series 7, **Photographs**, 1867-1983 [1910-1978], 3.00 linear feet, contains photographs from Russia of Ivask's family, ancestral house, relatives and friends. It also contains photographs from his personal and professional life in America (e.g. group pictures of the faculty at Middlebury) and trips abroad.

Series 8, **Films and Tapes**, 1967-1976, 0.5 linear feet, contains an unidentified film; filmstrips on Leontiev and Rozanov; and tape-recordings Yesenin reading his poetry; Yarmolinskii, *On the Road* (1976); Mamleev, *The Last Trace of Spinoza*, *Village Life*, *Talk on Dissident literature* (1975) arranged in chronological order.

History of the Papers

The Papers were purchased in 1987 from Ivask's estate by Amherst College. One of the executors, Ivask's friend and collaborator William Tjalsma [Chalsma], was instrumental in the purchase and packing of the Papers after Ivask's death.

A portion of the Papers, Correspondence Series I, was sorted by Joe Kass and Andrea Smith between October 1987 to May 1988. The rest of the material was organized, sorted and catalogued by Peter Luborsky during the summers of 1990, 1991 and 1992.

A portion of Ivask's correspondence had been previously donated to the Yale University Archives. Photocopies of some of these letters were sent back to Ivask by the Curator of Slavic Archives, Alexis Rannit, and these are located in Series 6, Box 34. Removed from the collection were books from Ivask's collection, which were transferred to the library. Also removed were numerous art post-cards, which were given to appropriate departments at the College.
