## Proceedings

- 1. Betsy and Suzanne shared the Committee on Institutional Advancement report from the October Trustee Meeting
  - a. Overview of the revised organizational structure and current open positions in Advancement.
  - b. Update on the financial goals of the Promise Campaign: As of October 14, \$453.4M has been raised from 23,121 donors. The college has reached 72.5% of the overall campaign goal of \$625M.
  - c. Campaign is designed both to achieve the dollar goal and to build donor capacity for future campaigns.
  - d. Financial goal setting is based on donor prospects at different levels of giving.
  - e. Report on progress by Priorities of campaign and an update on gifts received toward each goal.
  - f. Annual Fund financial results are holding steady with prior years, however there is a desire to increase the participation rate, with a strategic focus on Young Alumni. Advancement tracks Annual Fund by donor demographics and engagement percentages.
- 2. Advancement always needs faculty engagement and participation in events. Pass along stories of students and alums, and share news about alums coming to campus or mentoring.
