# Requests

#### 1. Korean Students Association

- Rep: for movie night we would watch a cultural movie
- Rep: study breaks, monthly, are our discussion meetings so discussion food for that
- Jacob explains food policy, one discussion food per semester, already allocated for Running Man
  - o Rep: Running Man event is bigger and could we get food separately?
  - o Jordan E: you already have integral food
  - Olivia: because they designated one event as hallmark event, they can't get anything else?
- J explains all the food policy, one for each guideline
  - o J: utensils are per event though
- J: what we've explained already, intro, discussion, integral, and hallmark are taken
- J: we can zero Running Man and move the allocation over to a different event
  - o Rep: no, Running Man is more important
- J: if you don't end up spending all the food money you can reallocate
  - o cultural food discussion is not revisited
- Rep: reallocate \$25 to intro meeting and \$25 to Running Man
- J: BC you can also vote on adding publicity because we also zeroed that
- Natalia: motion to recommend as is (6, 0, 0), approved

#### 2. Adventist Christians Together

- ACT and its BC representative did not propose a budget during club budget meeting, so club rep planned to pitch it during this meeting
- O: we just need to reformat events, so itemize things
  - o Rep: oh ok
- J: adds budget to the list
  - o N: so are we accepting budget during appeals?

- Ioannis: I think we can
- N's problem is that we weren't able to consider this during club budget meetings, meaning that it wasn't considered as part of the total club budget cost under the AAS's budget
- Will: also, precedent would be set to allow club budget propositions during appeals meetings
- seems that at least a few BC members are against having ACT's budget set during this meeting
- J: best case scenario is to come back during discretionary for specific events, seems that your proposed budget isn't too large
  - o J: next semester
  - o N explains that this isn't a personal thing
  - o I: it's fun to come to our discretionary meetings!

## 3. Amherst Mixed Martial Arts Organization (AMMO)

- Rep: specifically about the food for our promotion event
  - o we don't get to eat until after the belt ceremony so this is food after a food
  - o N: is it for anyone or just the promoted members
    - Rep: for anyone participating in the club, including those who get promoted
  - N: we just didn't think food was integral to the event
    - Rep: it would be a bigger meal, not just snacks, because we'll have been working out the whole day
    - BC members agree food is integral
- W: motion to recommend as is (6, 1, 0), approved
- J: you can reallocate food within the semester, shows rep how to do so
- I: (I have a black belt)
  - Woah woah what

#### Discussion

## 1. Coaches (specifically for Men's Club Soccer)

- I: what if club soccer says that we don't have the right to judge people they hire
  - o N: I would say we do
  - o N: we're effectively zeroing Stu, not a coach in general
- O: who was their coach before Stu graduated?
  - o J: didn't really have a coach/official team before Stu apparently

## 2. **RSO**

- N: will Intersections ever be an RSO?
  - o N: Intersections is exclusionary right?
  - o J: interesting question, what she's asking for is conference money though, which is a particular event that they could hold for the entire student body
    - N: but they also need cross semester funding
      - J: could potentially get funding from Student Activities
- O: if it's just the members of the club, then that's not within policy

- o O: also tickets and hotel cost more
- o N: also issue of inter-semester funding
  - J: I think there might be an accounting issue because student activities fees are mostly funding by semester
    - N: but if we make that a policy for both semesters then it should balance out
- J: I think we could also talk about the possibility of requiring dues again
  - o N: yeah
- J: I'll tell them to come back on Monday
- I: with regards to the cross-semester funding, if they get money they spend it now, and they are technically spending it now so it's not outside of policy
- O: I think you should check legal stuff too
  - o J: well it's not technically legal stuff, just easier for our accountant to deal with
- N: should we make a small policy about funding across semesters up to discretion of the budgetary committee?
